Abstract Perfection - A Personal Expression of Perfection

Opened September 16, three artists exhibit monumental, individualistic works at 1801 California

DENVER (September 15, 2015) – On September 16, [Arts Brookfield](#) opened the [Abstract Perfection](#) exhibit at 1801 California. With monumental abstract works by three artists, the exhibit depicts an act of vigorous and spontaneous personal expression. She further explains that for the artist, the process is almost more important than the final painting, and for the viewer, the painting becomes an experience through the artistic process to the artist’s unconscious.

The show runs from September 16 through November 13 and is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. The exhibit and reception are open to the public and free to attend.
