## SASSY SLOUCHY HAT

Free Crochet Pattern - Lion Brand® Vanna's Tapestry - Pattern Number: L32460

SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2) SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 16 1/2 in. (42 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes Finished Height About 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm)

### MATERIALS

- 864-204 Lion Brand Vanna's Tapestry: Caribbean 1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H (5 mm)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I or J (5.5 or 6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles

### GAUGE:

\*Vanna's Tapestry (Article #864). 100% acrylic; package size: 3.00oz/85.00 gr. (145yds/133m) pull skeins  
11 dc + 5 rnds = about 3 in. (7.5 cm) with larger hook.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in rounds from the top.
2. Every round is worked through the back loops and joined without turning.

HAT

Beginning at top, with larger hook, ch 4, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 8 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc - 16 sts at the end of this rnd.

Note: On Rnds 3-23, work through back loops only and join with sl st at the end of each rnd.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) 7 times - 24 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, (sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 8 times - 32 sts.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, (sc in each of 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 8 times - 40 sts.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, (sc in each of 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 8 times - 48 sts.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, (sc in each of 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 8 times - 56 sts.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, (sc in each of 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 8 times - 64 sts.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, (sc in each of 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 8 times - 72 sts.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, (sc in each of 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 8 times - 80 sts.

Rnd 11: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each st around.

Rnds 12-17: Rep Rnd 11.

Dec Rnd 18: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each of next 5 dc, (dc2tog over next 2 dc, dc in each of next 6 dc) 9 times, dc2tog over last 2 dc - 70 sts.

Dec Rnd 19: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each of next 4 dc, (dc2tog over next 2 dc, dc in each of next 5 dc) 9 times, dc2tog over last 2 dc - 60 sts.

Band

Change to smaller hook.

Rnds 20-23: Ch 1, sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
